

INVITATION FOR BIDS

The Slate Belt Regional Police Department will receive sealed bids for construction work, until 11:00 am local time, on Friday, June 12 at 6292 Sullivan Trail, Nazareth, PA 18064. All bids will be publicly opened and read at that time.

The following construction contracts will be received:

General Construction
Mechanical Construction
Plumbing Construction
Electrical Construction

Proposed forms of contract documents, including plans and specifications can be only obtained as follows:

- A. Sets of bidding documents may be obtained electronically from the Office of the Architect at no charge. Contact the Architect by phone or e-mail.
- B. Sets of bidding documents may be obtained at the office of the Architect, Fedetz & Martin Associates, P.C., 1837 Roth Avenue, Allentown, PA 18104, (610)432-9924. Main@FMAarch.com Plan fee is thirty dollars (\$30.00) per set for all hard copies. This should be a check payable to Fedetz & Martin Associates, P.C. This fee is non-refundable.
- C. Bidding Documents may also be examined at the offices of the Architect, address as stated above.
- D. Postal & delivery charges are the responsibility of the bidder.
- E. Firms who have received the Invitation for Bids package from a source other than Fedetz & Martin Associates, PC need to provide us with their company name, mailing address, telephone number, fax number, contact name and e-mail address. This will ensure that the company receives all Invitation for Bid related communications and documents, including addenda.

Bid Security in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the base bid, is required with all bids in the form of a certified check or bank draft, payable to the Slate Belt Police Department, or a bid bond executed by the bidder in the form as enclosed with the bid documents. The successful bidder will be required to furnish and pay for satisfactory performance and payment bond or bonds as listed below:

Performance Bond shall be one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Amount.

Payment Bond shall be one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Amount.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held on Wednesday, June 3 at 1:30 PM at the building.

Attention is called to the provisions for equal employment opportunity.

The Slate Belt Regional Police Department reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informality in the bidding.

No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days subsequent to the opening of the bids without the consent of the Slate Belt Regional Police Department.
