Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) Permit - Pollutant Reduction Plan Public Notification

The goals of all MS4 programs as required by PADEP are to reduce the discharge of pollutants from the Township to protect water quality and to satisfy requirements of the Clean Water Act. As part of the MS4 permit requirements, the Township is required to prepare a Pollutant Reduction Plan (PRP.) The specific goal of the PRP Plan is to reduce siltation in the Little Bushkill Creek and Waltz Creek. The proposed PRP Plan consists of streambank restoration along certain portions of the Little Bushkill Creek. As required by PADEP, this notice is being published to inform the public that the Township intends to submit a PRP Plan to PADEP on or before April 3, 2018. A minimum 30-day public comment period will commence on the date of this publication and will terminate on March 14, 2018. Public comments will be officially accepted at the March 14, 2018 regularly scheduled Board of Supervisors meeting. The Township will consider and make a record of the consideration of each timely comment received from the public during the public comment period concerning the plan, identifying any changes made to the plan in response to the comments.
